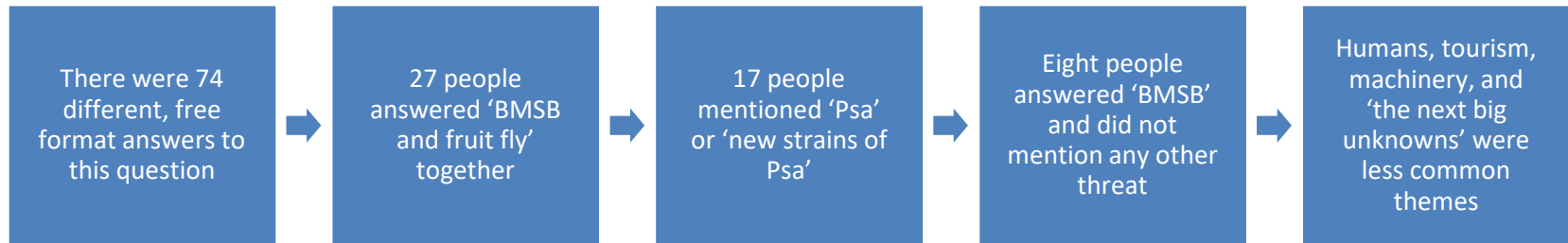


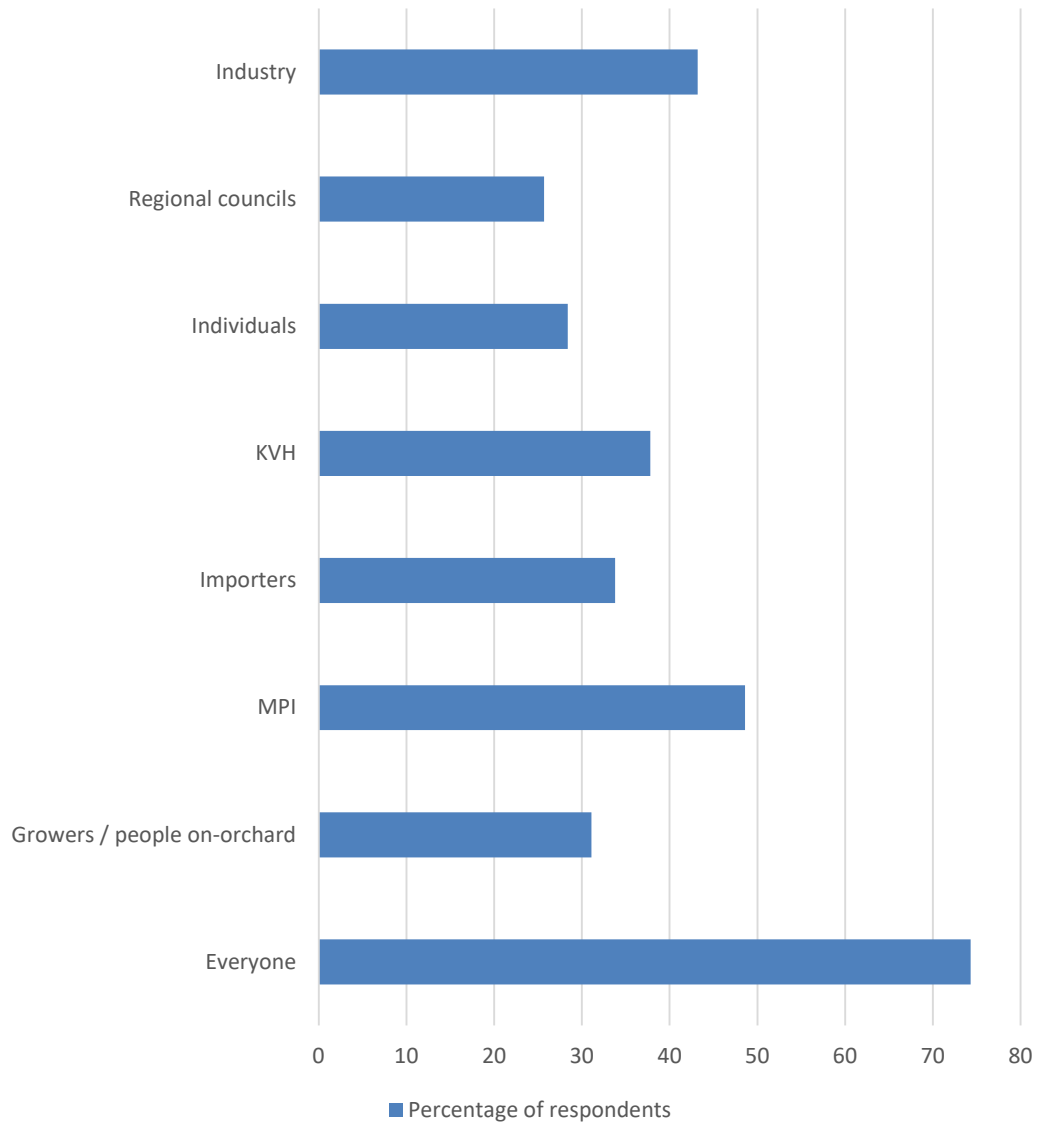

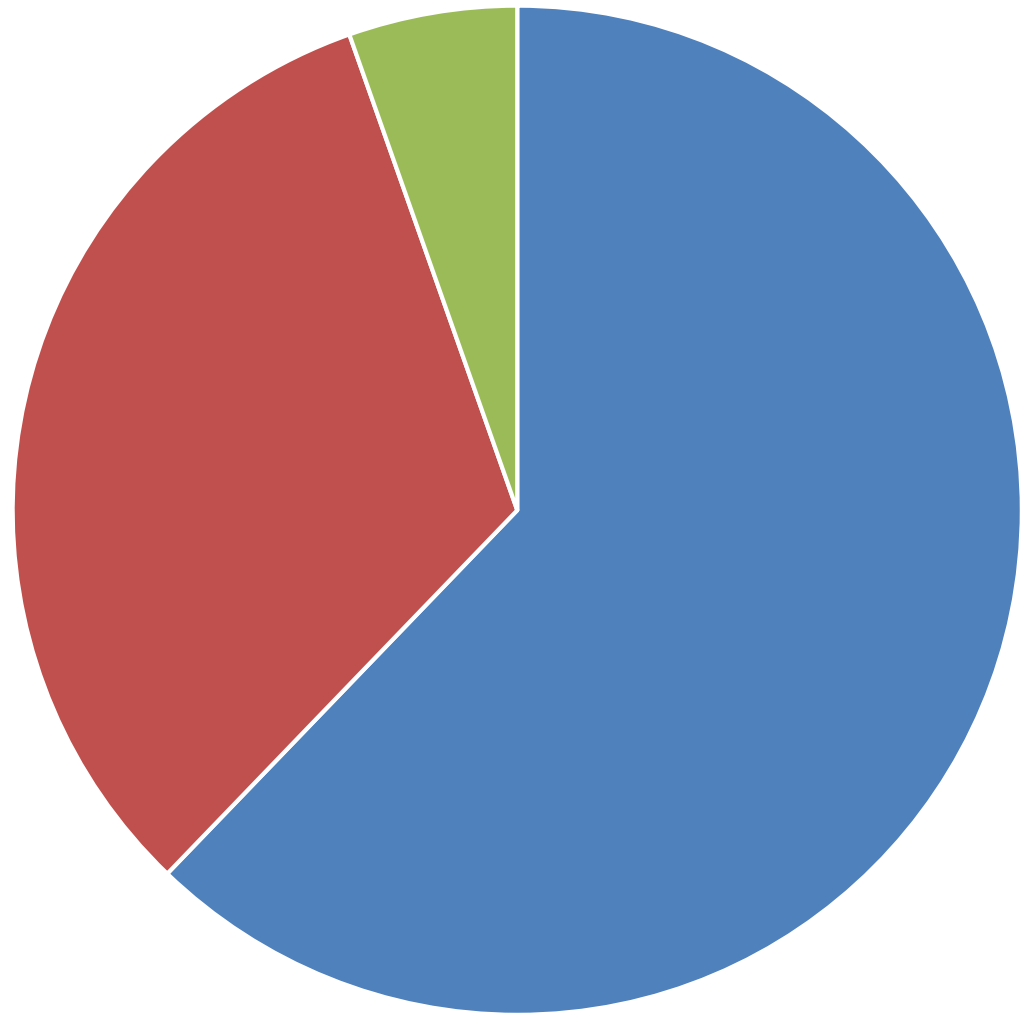


**What do you think are the biggest biosecurity pest and disease threats to the kiwifruit industry?**

Monitoring and implementing the plan for biosecurity

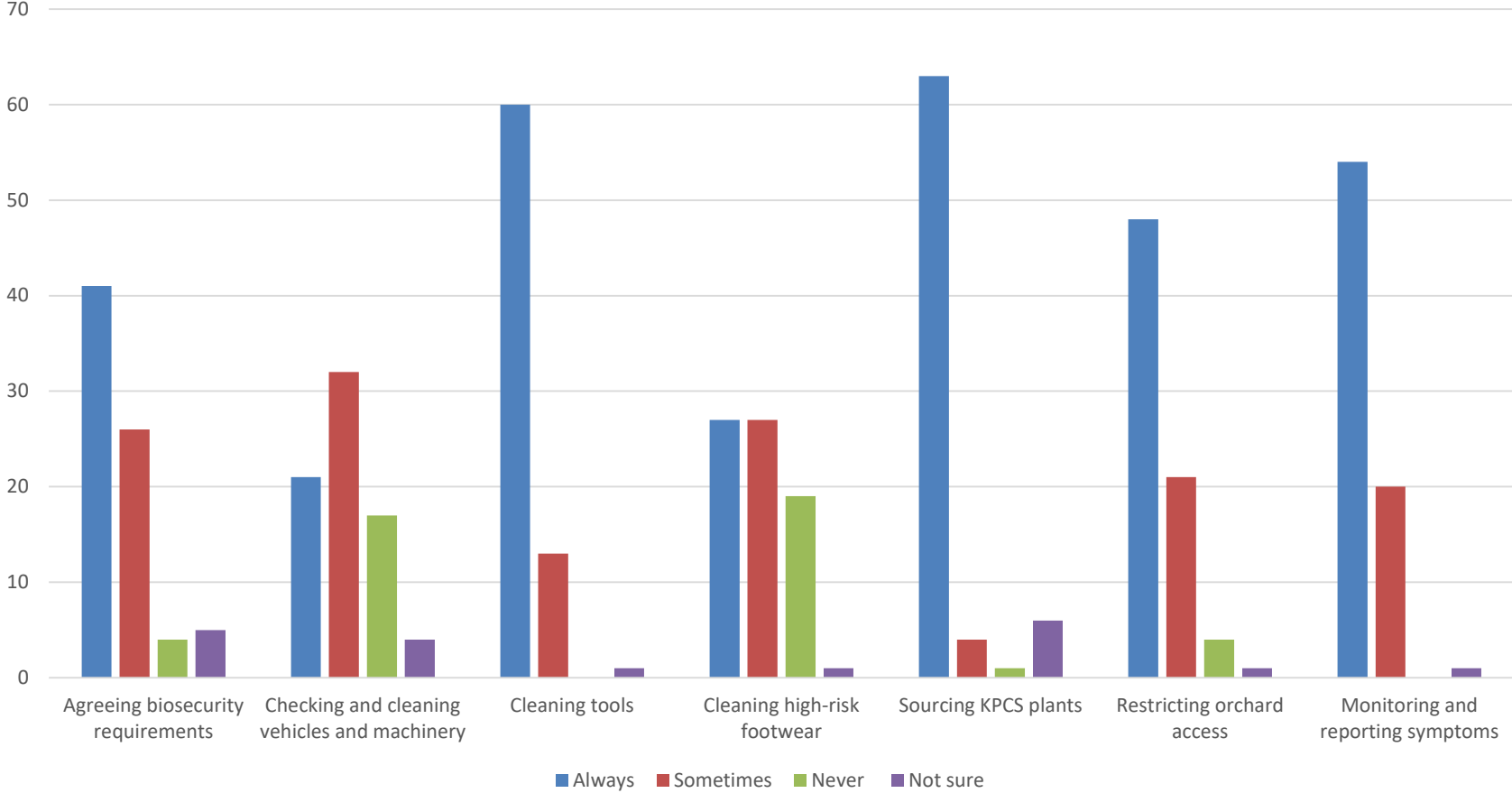

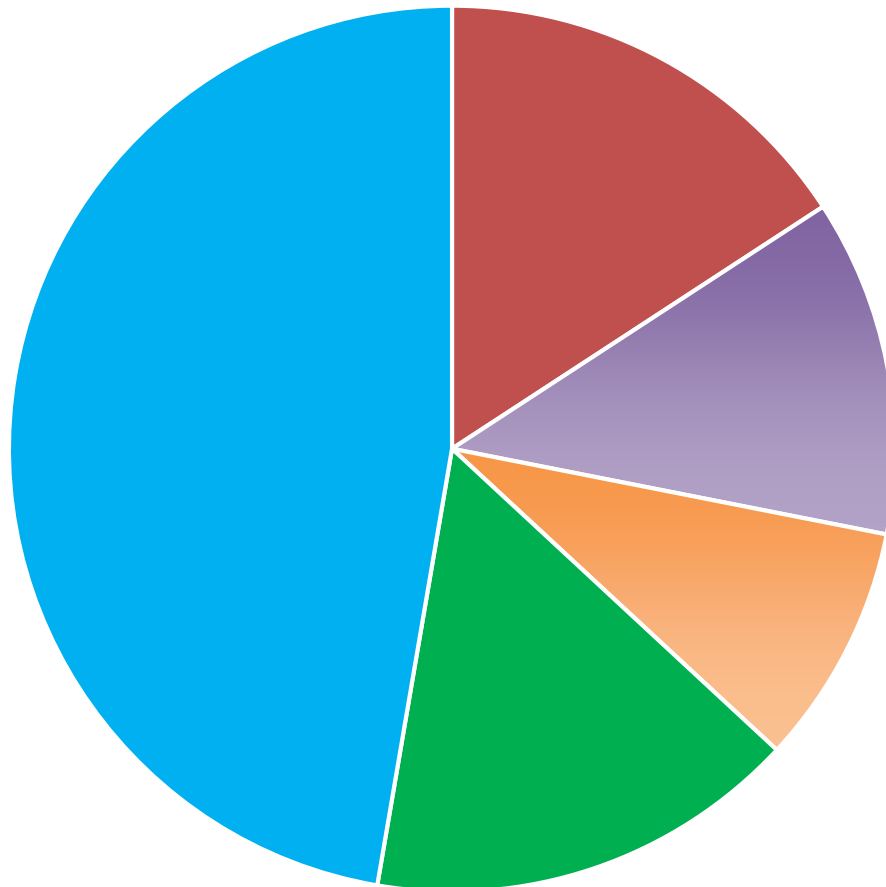

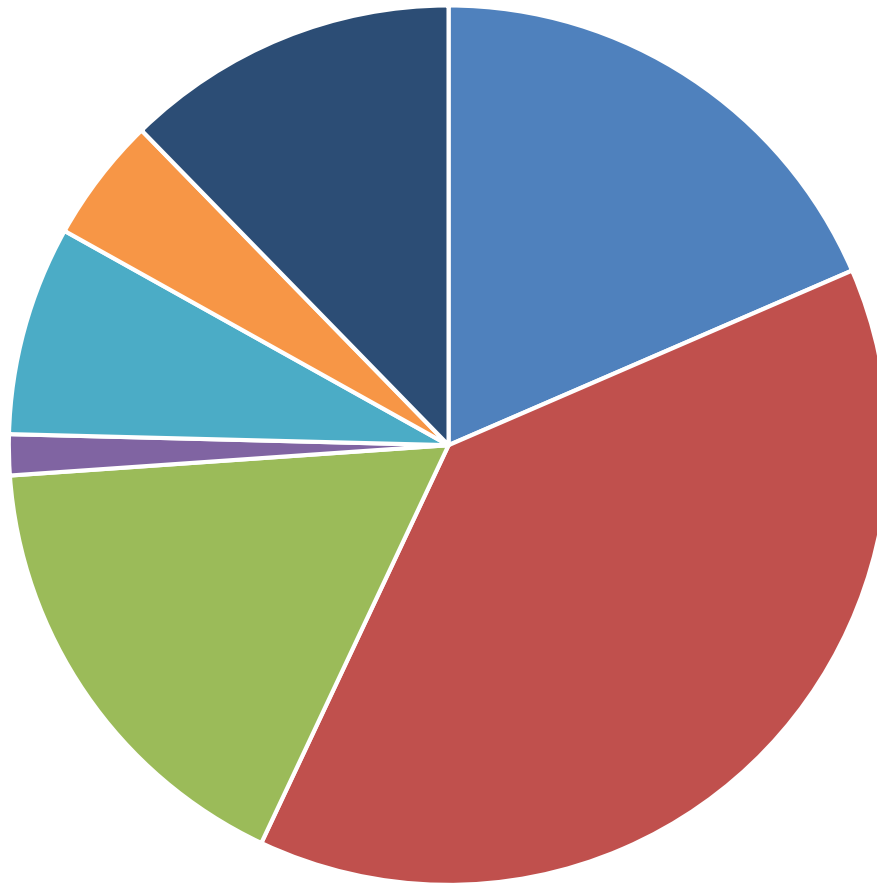
# How often are these biosecurity practices undertaken on the orchard you work on or are in charge of?

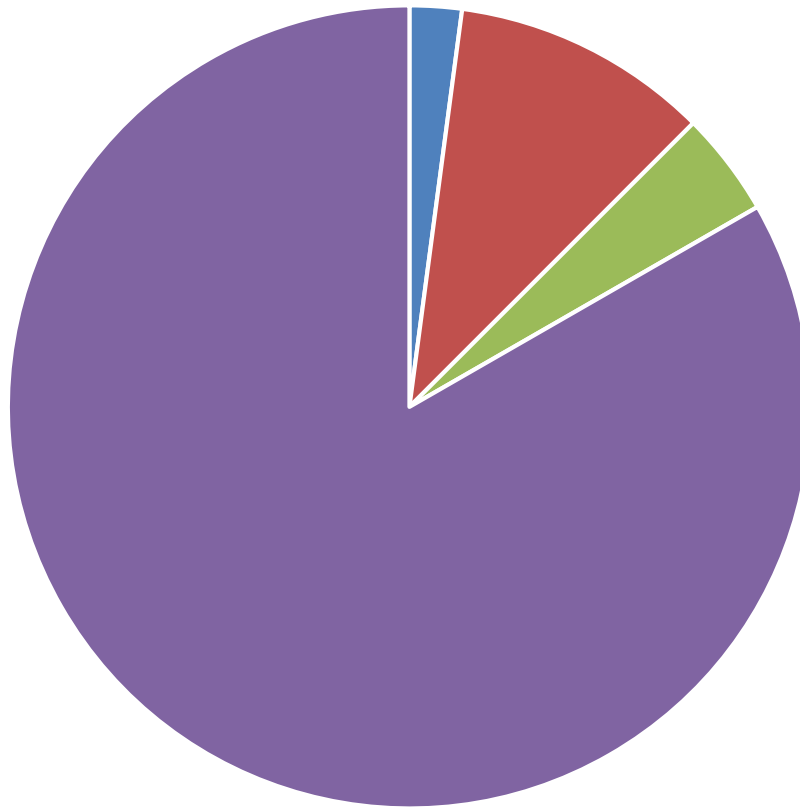
**What limits you from agreeing biosecurity requirements with the people you work with (or who work for you)?**

**What limits you from checking and removing soil/plant material from the vehicles and machinery that come on to your orchard**





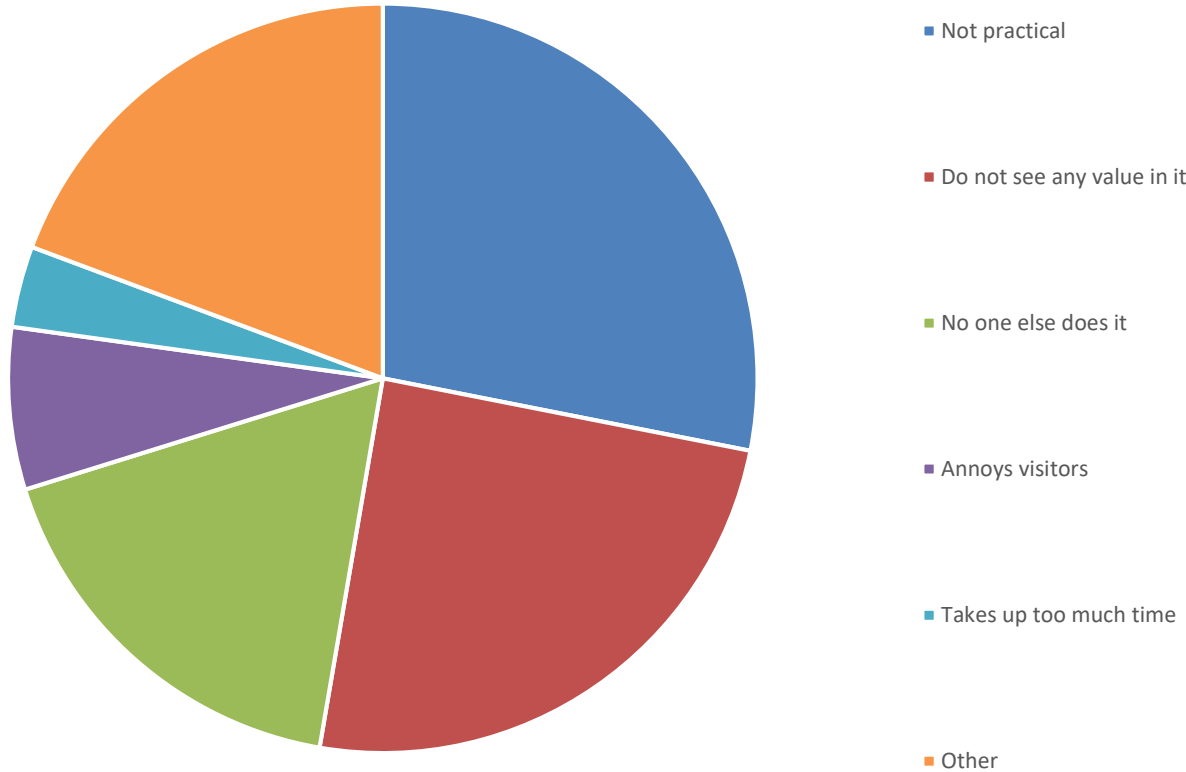

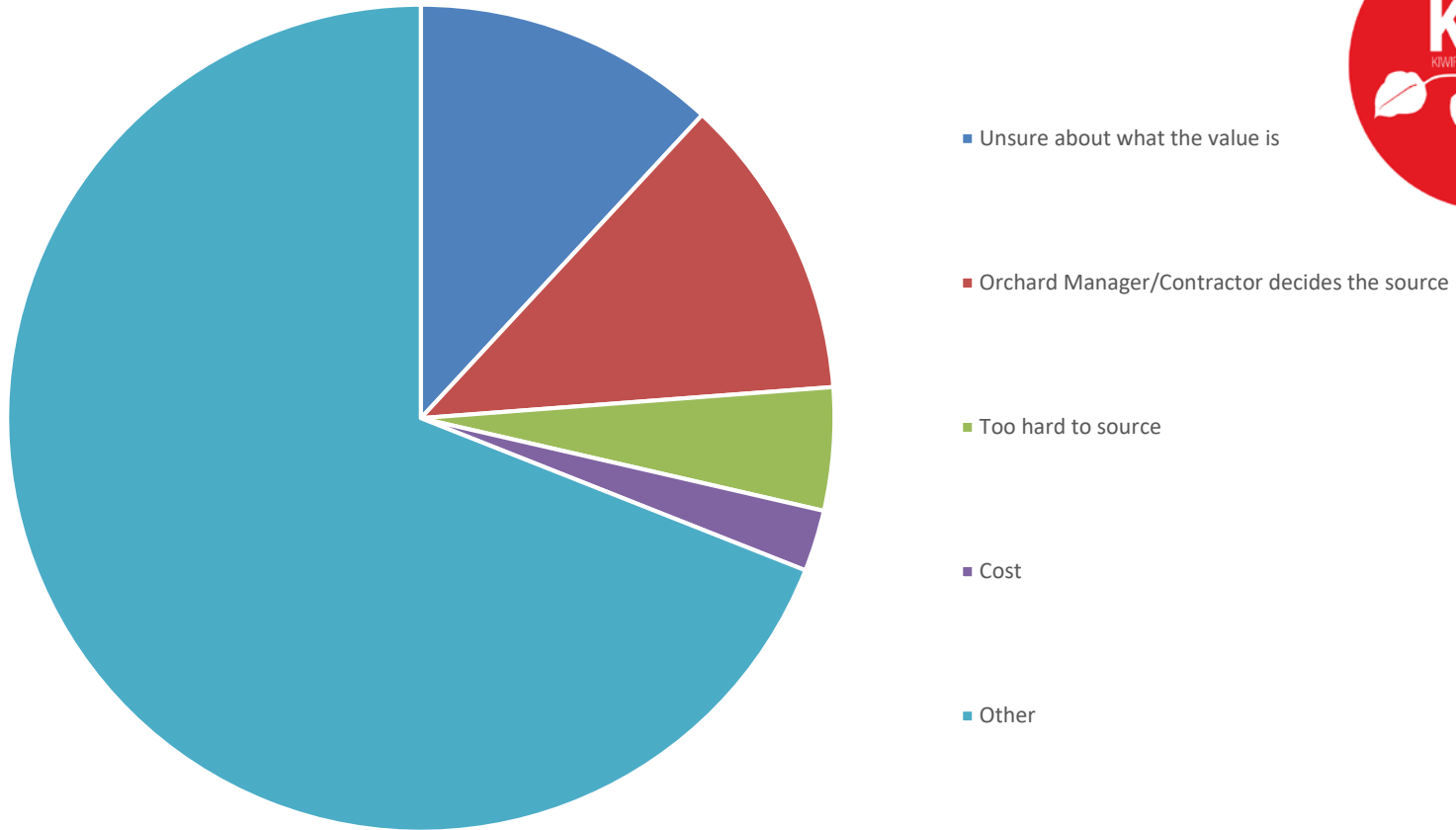

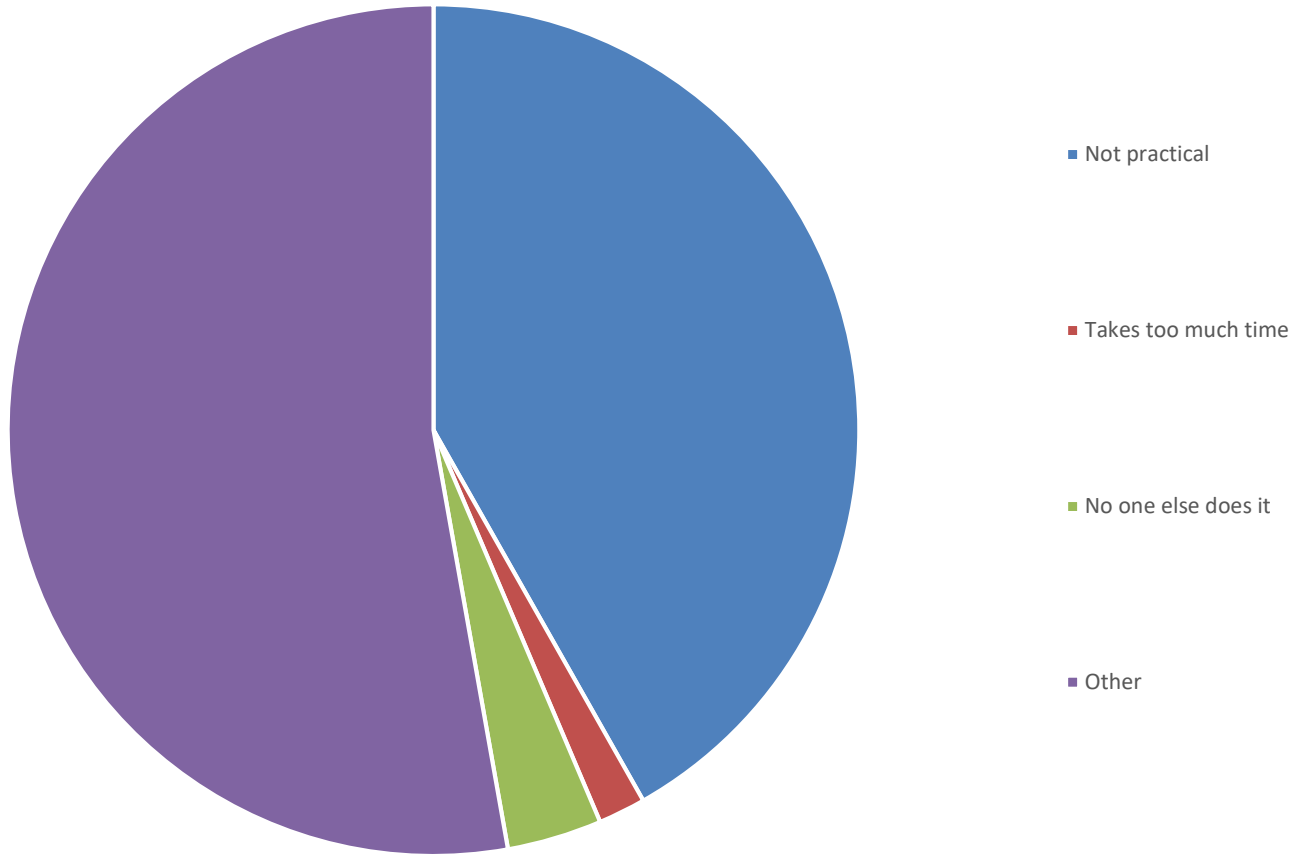
**What limits you from cleaning tools that come on to your orchard with an effective sanitiser?**



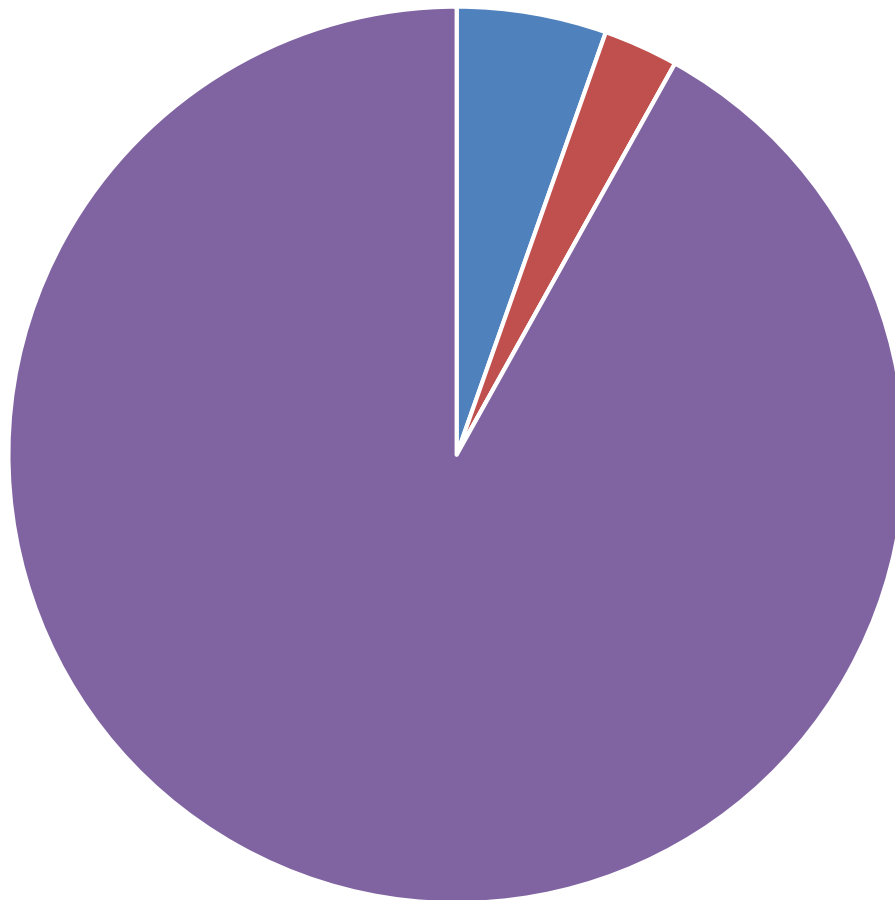
**What limits you from cleaning high-risk footwear that comes on to your orchard with an effective sanitiser?**
