NOTICE UNDER SECTION 131(3) OF THE BIOSECURITY ACT 1993 OF MOVEMENT CONTROLS ON KIWIFRUIT PLANT MATERIAL (EXCLUDING BUDWOOD, ROOTSTOCK, PLANTS, ANY PARTS OF A KIWIFRUIT PLANT USED IN PLANT PROPAGATION, FLOWERS, POLLEN AND FRUIT)

- Pursuant to section 131(3) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, I hereby give notice that the following controls apply to kiwifruit plant material (excluding the material listed in sub-clause (1) (a)) being moved into, out of, within or between areas declared as controlled areas for the purpose of managing the spread of *Pseudomonas syringae* pv. *actinidiae*, under the National Psa-V Pest Management Plan.
 - a) The following kiwifruit plant material is excluded from this notice:
 - Budwood (Note: requirements associated with movement of budwood is covered in the Notice under section 131(3) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 of movement controls on kiwifruit budwood);
 - ii. Rootstock, plants and any part of a kiwifruit plant used in plant propagation (Note: requirements associated with movement of these are covered in the Notice under section 131 (3) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 of movement controls on kiwifruit rootstock, plants and any part of a kiwifruit plant used in plant propagation);
 - iii. Flowers, flower parts and pollen (Note: requirements associated with movement of these are covered in the Notice under section 131(3) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, of movement controls on kiwifruit flowers, flower parts and pollen);
 - iv. Kiwifruit fruit that may be contaminated with plant material (other than fruit that has been processed and packaged, whether for domestic consumption or for export) (Note: requirements associated with movement of these are covered in the Notice under section 131(3) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 of movement controls on kiwifruit fruit that may be contaminated with kiwifruit plant material);
 - v. Kiwifruit fruit that has been processed and packaged for domestic consumption or export (Note: no movement controls apply to fruit that has been processed and packaged for domestic consumption or export under the National Psa-V Pest Management Plan).
 - vi. Kiwifruit plant material used for floral displays (Note: requirements associated with movement of this is covered in the Notice of Declaration of Controlled Area Under Section 131(2) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, of Movement Controls on Kiwifruit Plant Material Use in Floral Displays).
 - b) Kiwifruit plant material covered by this notice includes:
 - i. any kiwifruit vine material that is cut out or pruned from, or has naturally dropped from, kiwifruit vines on an orchard;
 - ii. any kiwifruit vine or vine material removed from a home garden or non-commercial orchard;
 - iii. compost or any other soil mix or gardening product containing kiwifruit plant material; and
 - iv. kiwifruit wood for use as firewood;

- These controls apply to all areas declared as controlled areas in the **Notice of Declaration of Controlled Areas Under Section 131(2) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 in Respect of the Pest,***Pseudomonas syringae pv, actinidiae.
- 3 Movement controls apply to kiwifruit plant material (as defined in clause 1) as follows:
 - a) The following movements are <u>allowed</u>, subject to meeting the conditions set out under clause (4):
 - i. All movements within an Exclusion Region;
 - ii. All movements within a Recovery Region.
 - b) The following movements are prohibited:
 - i. All movements from a Recovery Region to a Containment or Exclusion region
 - ii. All movements from a Containment Region to another Containment region or to an Exclusion region.
 - iii. All movements between Exclusion regions.
 - c) All other movements (i.e. those not covered under sub-clauses (3) (a) or (b) are restricted and may only be carried out with a permission issued by KVH, including:
 - i. All movements within a Containment Region
 - ii. All movements from a Containment region to a Recovery region
 - iii. All movements from an Exclusion Region to a Recovery or a Containment Region.
 - iv. All movements from another part of New Zealand, outside of Exclusion, Containment or Recovery Regions to any Exclusion, Containment or Recovery Region.
- The following conditions apply to any movement of kiwifruit plant material (as defined in clause 1):
 - a) All plant material awaiting movement must be securely stored and handled in a way that prevents dispersal of any kiwifruit plant material.
 - b) All plant material must be fully covered during transport to prevent escape of any kiwifruit plant material.
 - c) Compost containing kiwifruit plant material must only be moved from KVH approved compost manufacturers (refer KVH Protocol: Disposal Options.
 - d) Every person disposing of kiwifruit plant material from a Psa-V positive orchard must adhere to the 'KVH protocol: Disposal Options', available on the KVH website at http://www.kvh.org.nz/vine_removal.
- Any kiwifruit plant material moved in contravention of this notice may be seized by an inspector or authorised person and destroyed, treated or otherwise dealt with.
- Failure to comply with the requirements of this notice may result in a prosecution under the Biosecurity Act 1993. If convicted an individual could be liable to a term of imprisonment not exceeding 3 months, or a fine not exceeding \$50,000 or both. A corporation convicted of an offence under this notice is liable to a fine not exceeding \$100,000.
