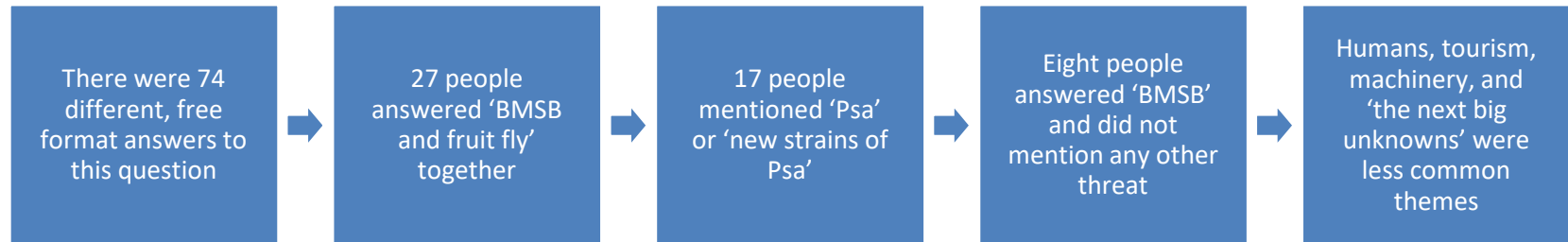


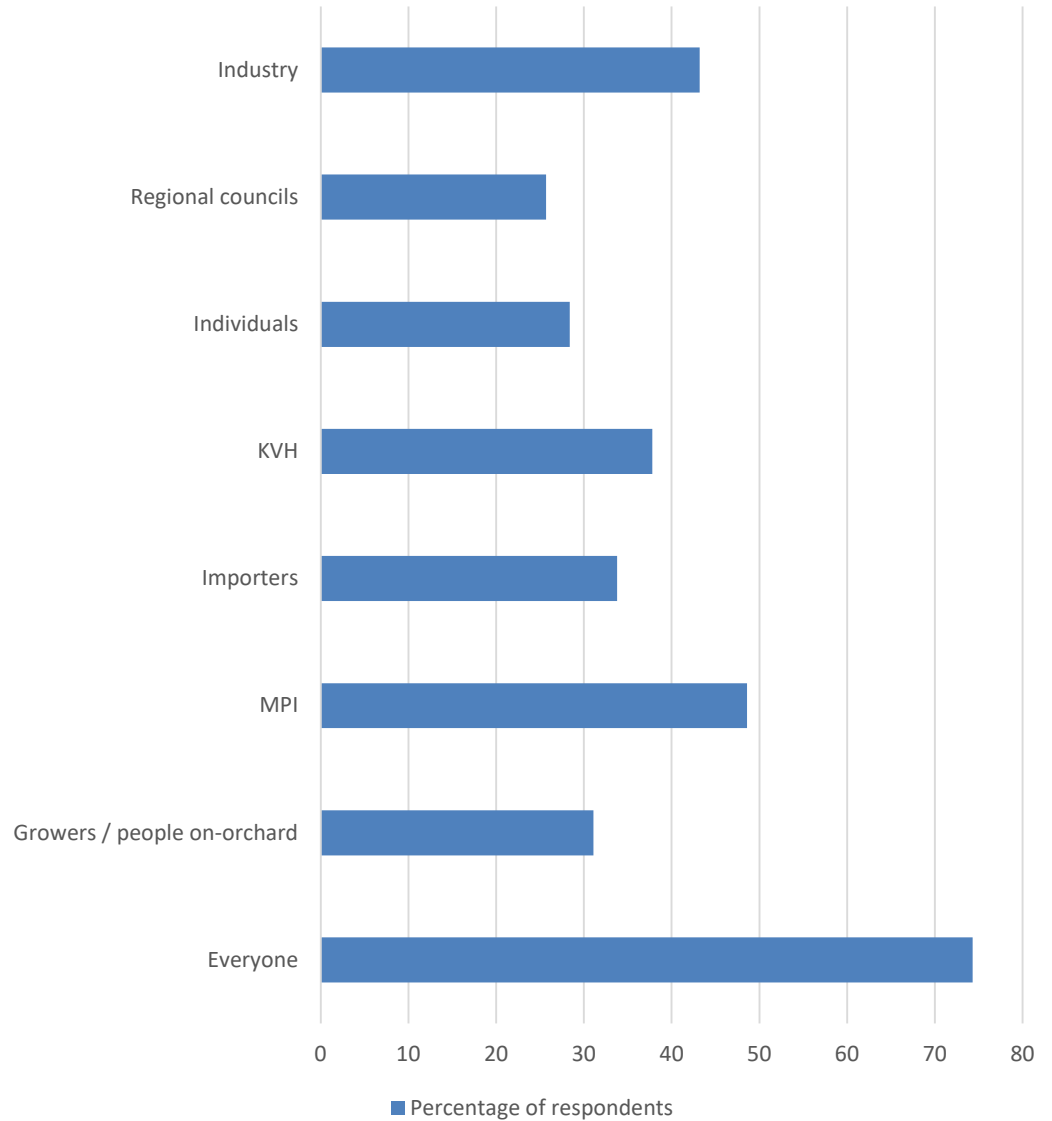

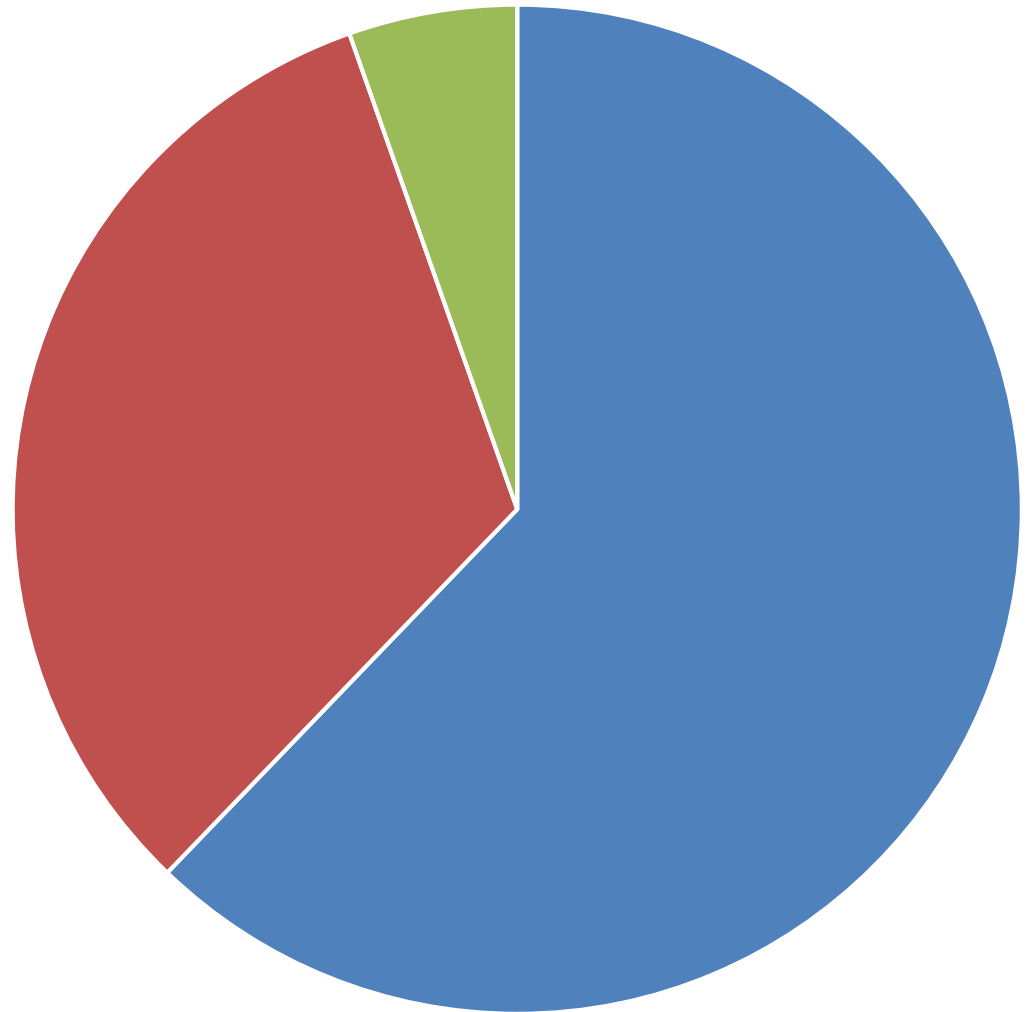


What do you think are the biggest biosecurity pest and disease threats to the kiwifruit industry?

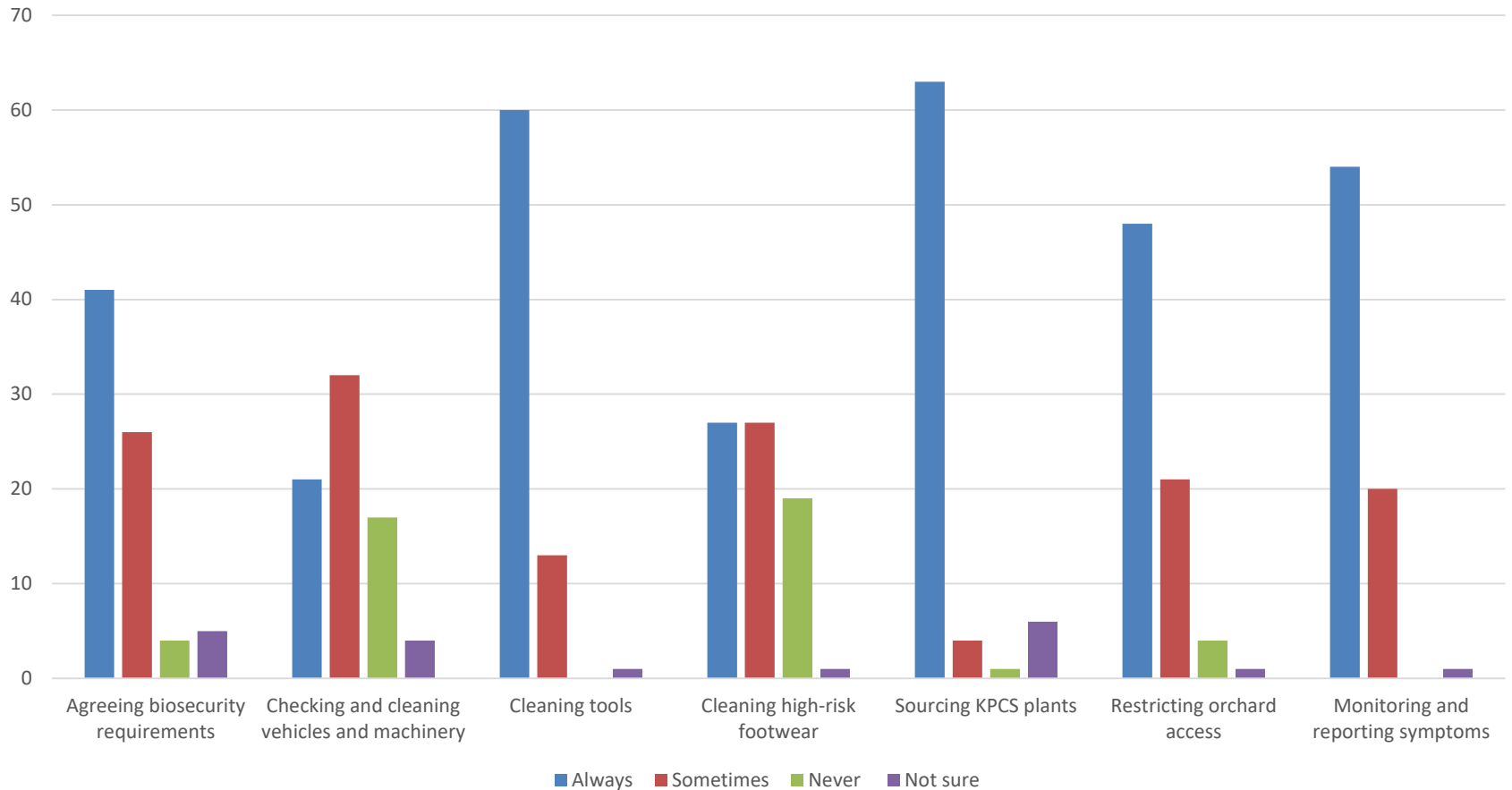

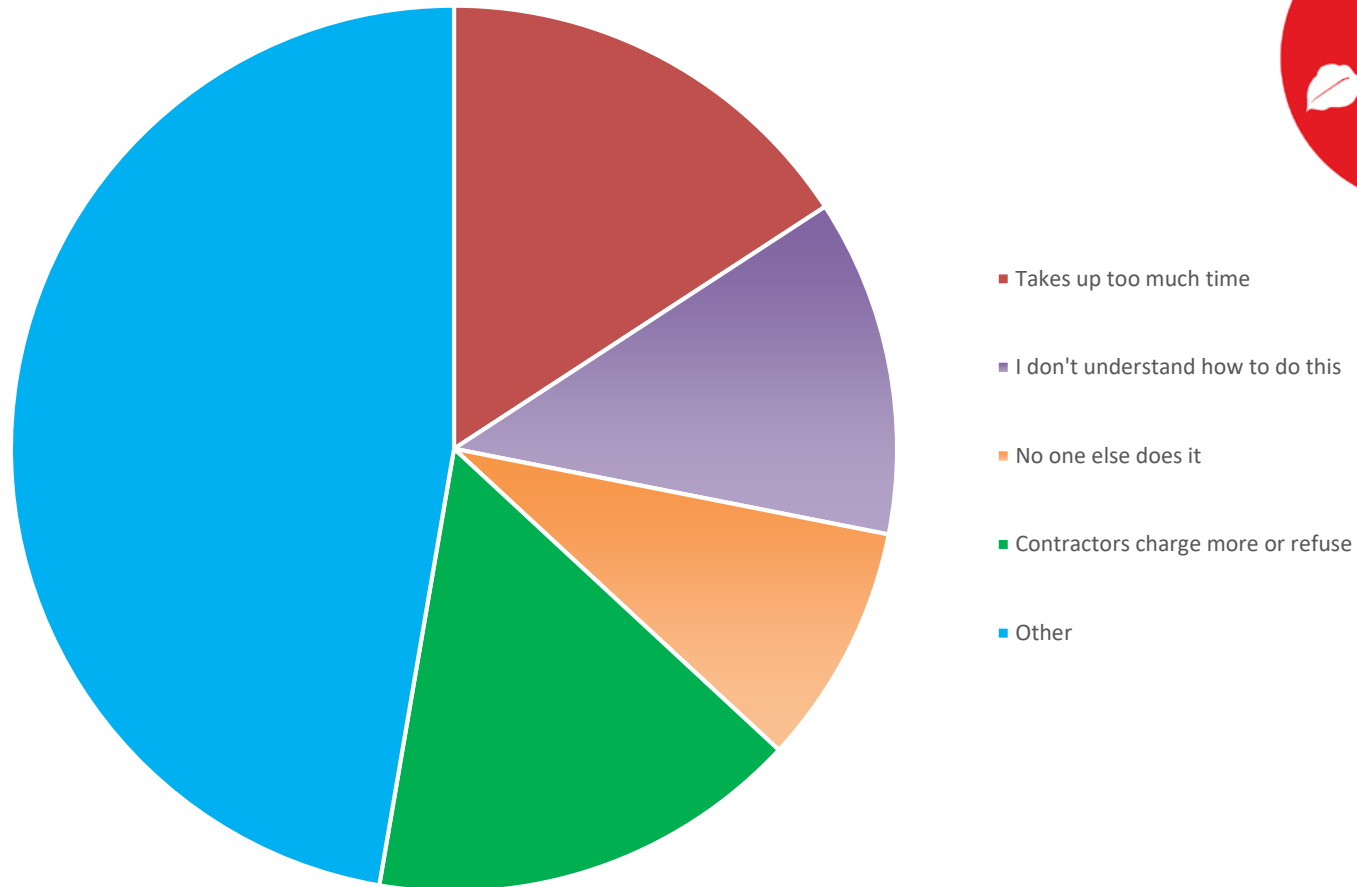

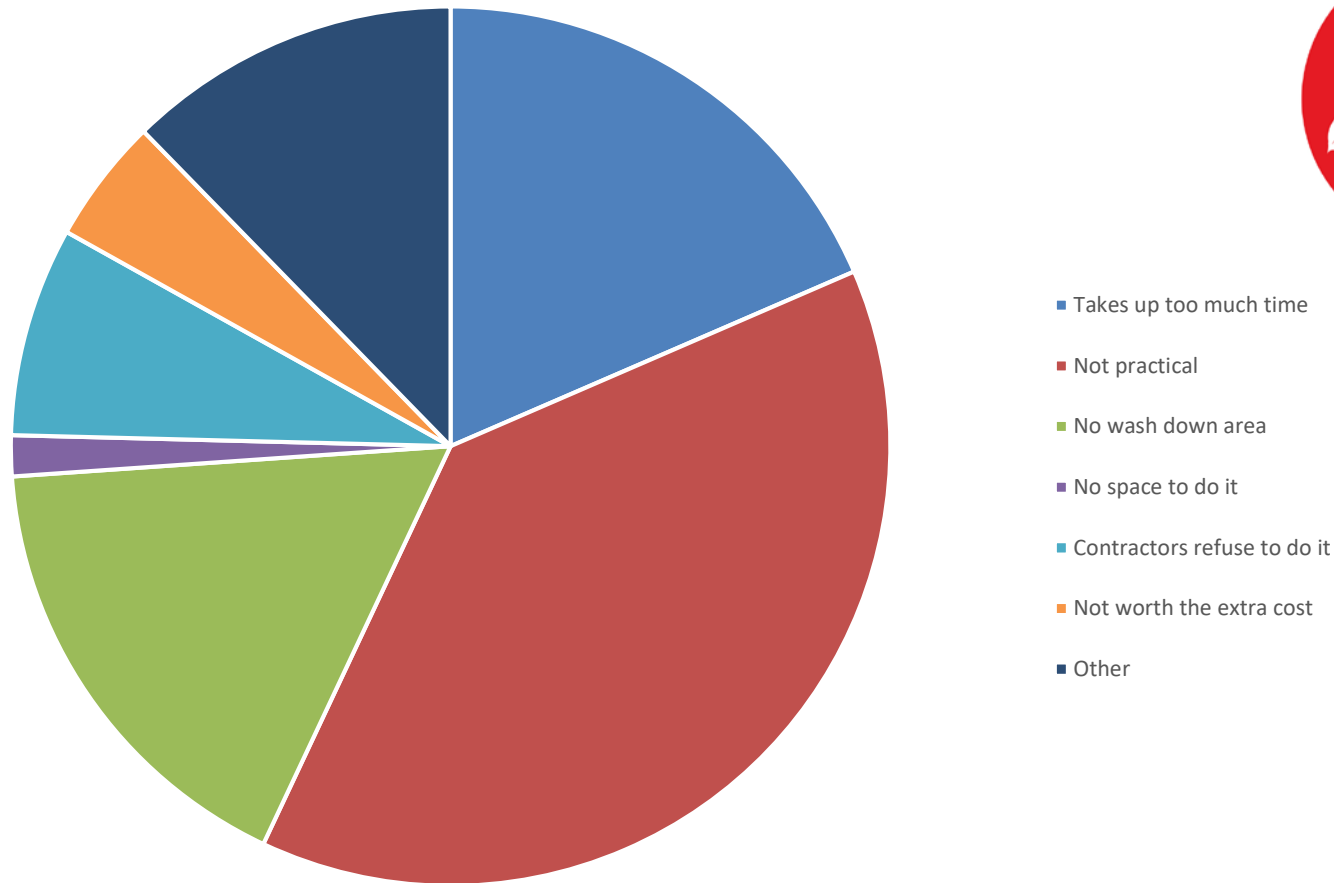

How often are these biosecurity practices undertaken on the orchard you work on or are in charge of?

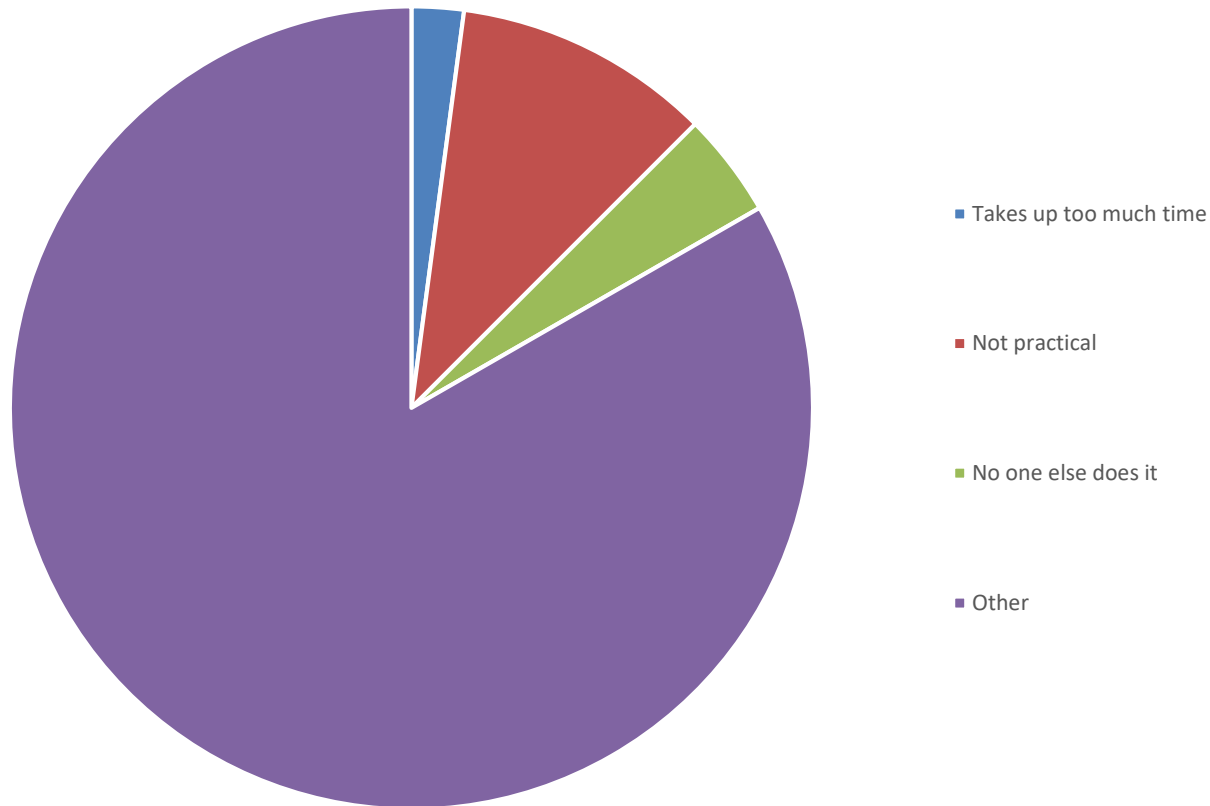




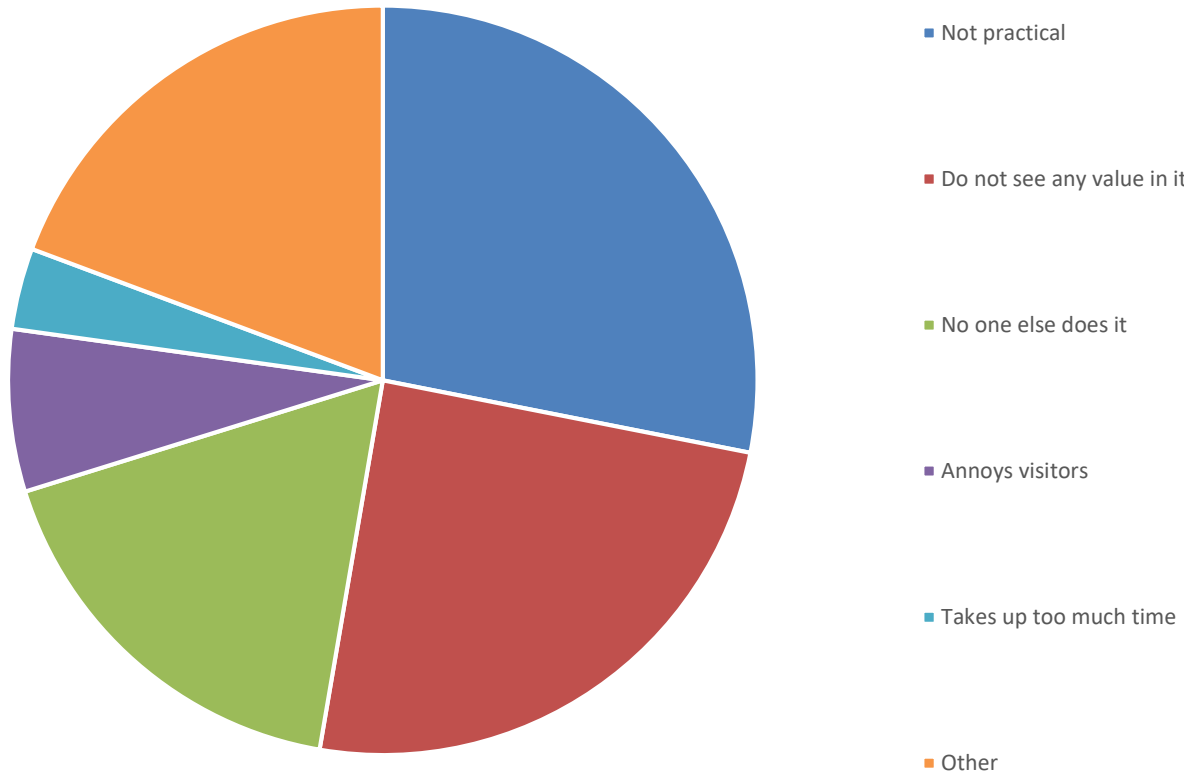
What limits you from agreeing biosecurity requirements with the people you work with (or who work for you)?



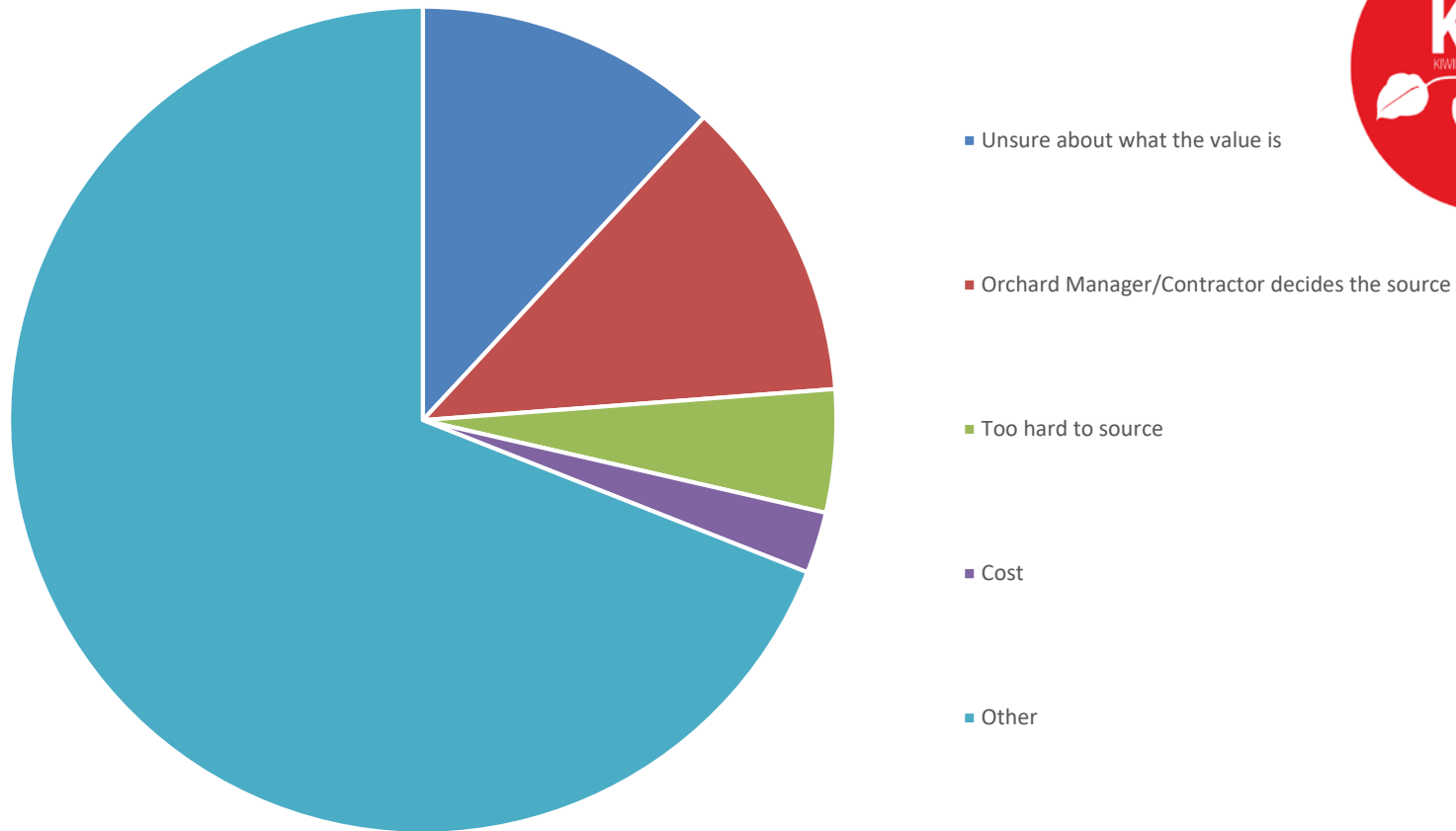
What limits you from checking and removing soil/plant material from the vehicles and machinery that come on to your orchard



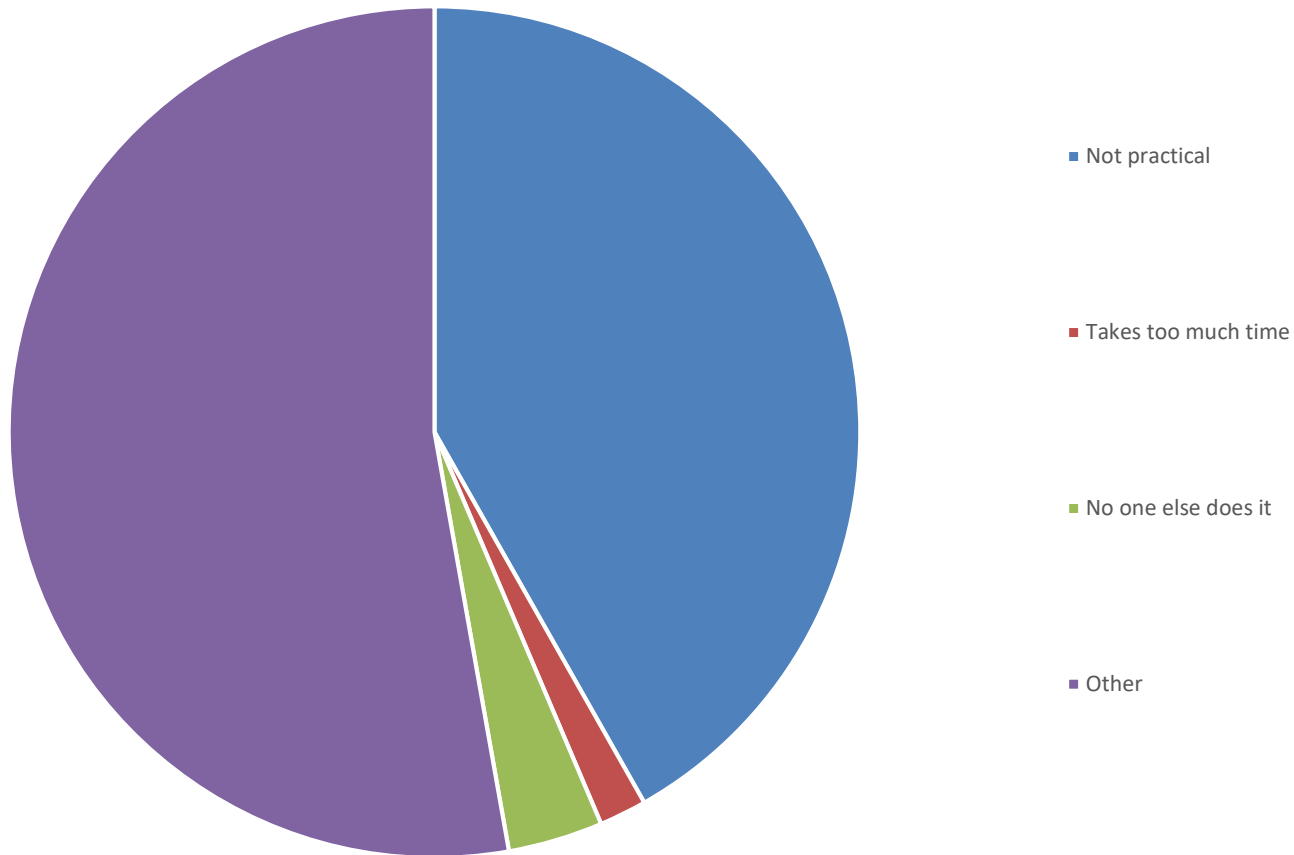
What limits you from cleaning tools that come on to your orchard with an effective sanitiser?



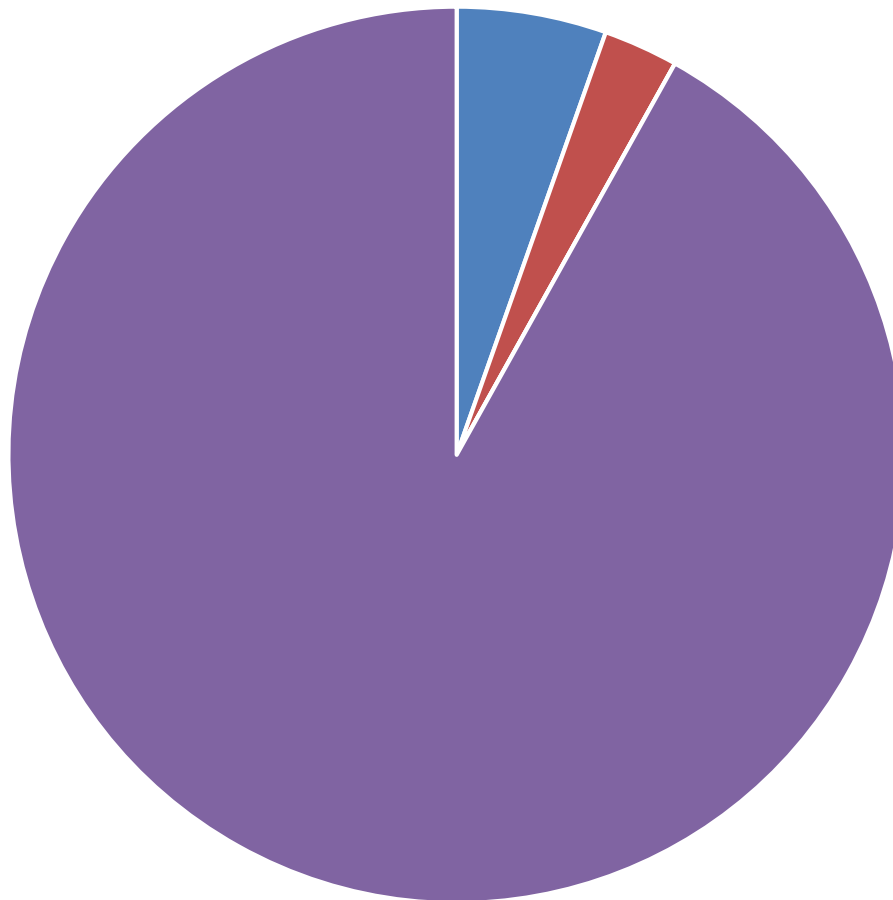
What limits you from cleaning high-risk footwear that comes on to your orchard with an effective sanitiser?
