High-risk season summary:



BMSB (Sep- April):


- 45% decrease in total bugs this season (986)
- 16% decrease in live bugs (47)
- Successful treatment programme alongside Australia
 - 210 registered; 25 countries
- One BMSB find in surveillance trap in Auckland

Fruit Fly (Sep- May):


- 3 fruit fly finds at our borders - one QFF, one Oriental FF and one Pacific FF

WPS (Dec-Feb):

- Two detections this season


