

## Notice of Declaration of Controlled Area and of Movement Controls on Kiwifruit Plant Material Use in Floral Displays Under Sections 131(2) and 131(3) of the Biosecurity Act 1993

Pursuant to section 131(2) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, I hereby declare all parts of New Zealand a controlled area with regards to the movement of kiwifruit (*Actinidia spp.*) plant material used for floral displays, for the purpose of limiting the spread of *Pseudomonas syringa*e pv. *actinidiae* (Psa - V), being a pest under the National Psa-V Pest Management Plan (NPMP).

Pursuant to section 131(3) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I hereby declare that kiwifruit plant material is prohibited from sale, display or communication as part, or the whole, of any floral arrangement.
